**Meaning of CATHOLIC**  
Why do we call our Church “Catholic”?  
The dictionary tells us the word “catholic” means “universal”. The word “universal” comes from the word “universe”. Can you give me another name for “universe”? Yes, “universe” means the ‘whole world’. So then, just like the universe mans the whole world, the word Catholic takes in everything. It means whole, complete and entire.

How is our Church **Catholic**?  
Our Church is catholic in **doctrine**. It teaches exactly the same religion that Jesus taught. Its teachings are complete. Nothing is left out or changed. Our Church is catholic in **members**. People of every race, every nation, every class and every condition are welcome. No one who wants to believe and live the way the Catholic Church teaches is left out. The Church is catholic in **duration**. It will last throughout all time. Jesus said it would last till the end of time. The Church is catholic in **location**. It is spread throughout the whole world.

**IN THEIR OLD TESTAMENT**, God promised that the Kingdom of the Savior Jesus would be universal. In Psalm 86:9 we read: **“All the nations you have made will come to worship you, O Lord, and glorify your name.”**

Jesus, too (in the New Testament, which fulfills the Old), told His disciples that “The Gospel must be preached throughout the whole world.” (Matt 24:14). Probably the last instructions Jesus gave His Apostles before leaving this world and ascending into heaven was this: “Go, make disciples of ALL nations. Baptizing them...and teach them **everything** I have taught you.” (Matt 28:19-20). Jesus died to save **ALL** people. “ALL” means catholic, too.

For one thousand five hundred years after Jesus, **there was only one Church, the universal Catholic Church**. After about 1500 years, all kinds of people began making up all kinds of churches. They cannot be Catholic, they cannot be universal, because they came at least one thousand, five hundred years too late.

Throughout the world the Church is always growing. In every age of history men and women have worked among their own people or in distant lands to spread the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Church. Let us pray every day to the two great patron saints of missionaries: **St. Francis Xavier and St. Therese of Lisieux**.

St. Francis Xavier was a great Jesuit priest who preached the Gospel in Japan and India. He was a true hero of God who never tired of traveling and working to bring many people into the Church. St. Theresa was a Carmelite Sister who never left her convent in France. She became a missionary by offering her work, prayers and sufferings to Jesus for the success of missionaries throughout the world.

And, what about YOU and ME? As members of the Catholic Church we too must be missionaries. Perhaps God is calling some of us to the heroic life of a real missionary. As a priest or a religious brother or sister, a doctor or a teacher, we will spend our life sharing God’s message of salvation with people who do not yet know Him.

And even if we do not go to a foreign country, each one of us must be a “home missionary”. We must live our faith well. By our words and example, we must help others find out about our faith. We should also pray for all missionaries and generously help them.

**Every day let us ask God for a great heart—a Catholic, universal, missionary heart—big enough to hold the whole world! And of course, always be proud and thankful to be a member of the One, Holy, Apostolic, Catholic Church!**
