**A Unique Gift**

Motherhood is truly an unparalleled privilege granted to us by the merciful Lord, for in motherhood He allows us to participate in His divine act of creation. We co-operate with Him in the creation of human being, made in the image and likeness of God Himself and endowed with immortal souls, who with God’s grace, will have the opportunity of loving and praising God for all eternity in Heaven. Motherhood is also a tremendous gift and a blessing, for every child God sends us brings ineffable joy, love and laughter, as we watch each child’s unique personality unfold and blossom.

But motherhood is not like other gifts. Usually when someone presents us with a gift, that gift becomes ours, and we are free to do with it as we like. But not so with motherhood: we do not own our children; we cannot do as we like with them. Rather, we have an enormous responsibility and obligation toward these darling blessings whom God has temporarily placed in our care. We are to guide and teach them; we are to provide for their needs and serve them; we are to respect their individuality and undertake the delicate task of forming their unique characters in preparation for whatever wonderful vocation God has destined for them.

Thus, we must remember that our children are not merely bodies to be clothed and fed, but little people with thoughts and feeling of their own. On hectic days we must be careful not to treat our children as nuisances who are always in the way, just as the Apostles did when they rebuked the women who brought their children to be blessed by Our Lord; rather, like Our Lord, we must respect the individuality and sensitivity of our little charges and treat them as the people they are—little people, to be sure, but *people* nonetheless!

Children have so many needs that we may feel overwhelmed in trying to fill them all! We have, indeed, a huge task awaiting us with every child we bear. When we feel exhausted by changing diapers, cooking meals, washing dishes and scrubbing sticky fingers, we can easily fall into the mistake of seeing our children as mischievous nuisances who do nothing but spill food and make more work for us. We can begin to see ourselves as housekeepers whose job it is to run the household as smoothly and efficiently as our annoying charges will permit. We may for a while lose sight of our noble vocation as mothers to tend to the spiritual and emotional, as well to the physical, needs of the sensitive, vulnerable little people entrusted to our care. How often we may think, “How can I get any housework done today when I’m constantly shooing the toddlers away from the outlets, bookcases, stereo, bathroom, stove, etc. and breaking up fights between older and younger children?” And yet what is more important for us to “get done” besides these all-important trifles of teaching our children to obey their parents and to behave with charity towards one another? Which is a higher goal, a clean floor or an obedient, unselfish child? If children, who will love and respect God and their neighbor, then we must first give them the love and respect that they need and make them our first priority. They will not learn to respect us or anyone else if we do not first treat them with respect. And only in giving our children the love and respect they crave will we find all the joys and fulfillment inherent in the great privilege and precious gift of the vocation of motherhood.
