GRADUATION message, concerning Disadvantages

As a young man I graduated from high school in the depression years. There was no money to attend college, so I went to work in a hosier mill. For five years I worked, until I finally was able to save sufficient funds to enter college.

During those long years, I asked myself many times, "Why am I not able to gain an education like others?" I felt that those five years at work were lost years. But in the succeeding years I have realized that I gained an understanding of people that I could have gotten no other way. It was part of my total education and I am grateful for those years in the mill.

Once Booker T. Washington spoke of "the advantage of disadvantages." He knew where he spoke. Born in slavery, he had little opportunity to learn how to read and write. But, deep within, he had resolved to secure an education despite any handicaps. He was able to rise above his environment and become a wise, highly respected citizen.

Life can be too easy if we have no disadvantages. We learn to test our strength by tackling obstacles. The muscles of the mind are made strong by grappling with problems. Can it be that the heart of America has grown soft just because most of its people when faced with problems in their lives today, turn to others to fix it for them instead of imitating that resourcefulness of the pioneer, who buckled down to discover how they could cope with the problem that faced them?

Too often too, we as parents wish to make the road of life easier for our children, than it was for us. **Yet, in doing so, we actually lessen their capacity for dealing creatively with life and its challenges. We steal from them the joy of overcoming the obstacles and the discovery of talents hidden within themselves.**
