Mary-Joseph Influence

On the first Sunday after Epiphany, the Church places before us a picture of the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary and Joseph in the humble home of Nazareth.

The Gospel for this Sunday tells us that Jesus “went down with them, and came to Nazareth; and was subject to them. And His mother kept all these things carefully in her heart. And Jesus advanced in wisdom, age, and grace before God and men.”

In this day of materialism and ease, we need this lesson very much. Our homes must be patterned in quiet devotion and simplicity upon the home of Christ. The parents’ most sacred duty is to be Mary and Joseph to their children.

Parents must always remember that their children do not belong to them alone, but to God.

What a privilege: care for children! And what a responsibility! What is a home in which the members are possessed of sanctifying grace but Jesus, Mary and Joseph? All in that home must grow in wisdom and grace as they grow in age.

No boy, no girl, can ever come to be utterly bad who remembers the Chistlikness of a truly Christian Mother and Father in a Mary-Joseph home.

Dear Parents: Be fair to your children---give them manly and womanly examples, give them sound religious training, give them the inspiration of disciplined day-to-day living (such as the Golden Inspiration, early in their life) and above all give them the realization of spiritual values, almost before you teach them anything else. Do not care so much as to whether you are accumulating money in order to leave them a fortune. Too often the chances are against that being a blessing. But leave them a treasure of grace and inspiration, so that they are rich in mind, heart and soul. Then if you happen to leave them the fortune besides, if they have all other things, the fortune will be shorn of its possibilities of evil and will become an instrument of higher and nobler good!

Loving Mother and Father

It was a loving mother who said to her son one day: “There was a time when I would make you do things, when my word was law to you. If you disobeyed, I found a way of correcting you. But things have changed—in you. You are a young man and although you are yet under my roof, there are some things you must decide wholly for yourself. You are too big to require it. And he understood himself and his mother in that hour as he had never understood before.
